3. PREVIOUS MEETING

UNFORTUNATELY DUE TO COMPUTER MALFUNCTION THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS AGM MEETING HELD ON 7™ JUNE 2018 WERE NOT AVAILABLE FOR SIGNING

4. MATTERS ARISING

WEBSITE – GREG SAID HE HAD WORDS WITH CHRIS BROWN REGARDING THE WEBSITE NOT BEING UPDATED WITH ALL THE INFORMATION HE WAS PROVIDED WITH AND ALSO THE TIME IT WAS TAKING TO UPDATE LEAGUE TABLES ETC.

6. TREASURERS REPORT

JOHN POPLE HANDED OUT THE CURRENT BALANCE SHEET WHICH SHOWED A BALANCE IN HAND OF £2187.77, JOHN POPLE QUESTIONED THE BALANCE IN HAND AND ASKED IF THE PRIZE MONEY COULD GO BACK UP AS THERE WAS NO NEED TO KEEP THAT MUCH MONEY IN THE BANK

ROY SMITH FROM DARK HORSES SAID IT WOULD BE BETTER TO REDUCE THE LEAGUE FEES SO THAT ALL TEAMS CAN BENEFIT

JAMES COUNSELL FROM CLEEVE DEVILS SUGGESTED THAT WE COULD CONTACT THATCHERS TO GET A SPONSORSHIP DEAL FROM THEM BUT IT IS NOT THAT EASY TO GET MONEY FROM SPONSORS

SECRETARY/FIXTURE JOHN POPLE THANKED SHARON WILLIAMS FOR NOT RESIGNING PREVIOUSLY DUE TO PROBLEMS WITH TEAMS HE THEN ASKED PHIL BATTYE IF HE WOULD BE PREPARED TO DO THIS JOB AND HE DECLINED AS HE SAID HE HAD TOO MUCH ON THIS YEAR

> SHARON WILLIAMS SAID THAT SARAH HAINES COULD BE INTERESTED IN TAKING OVER THE ROLE AND THIS WAS PROPOSED BY ANDREW HOOPER - CLEEVE DEVILS AND SECONDED BY PHIL BATTYE - CONSERVATIVE CLUB
